Direction No. 01/ 2012 : - Constitution of Board of Studies.

WHEREAS Maharashtra University of Health Sciences Act,1998 (MAHARASHTRA ACT NO. X of 1999) has come into force w.e.f. 3rd June 1998;

AND

WHEREAS as per Section 32(2) of the Act, the University shall have such faculties as prescribed by Statutes and as per Section 36(1) of the Act, there shall be a Board of Studies for every subject or group of subjects as prescribed by Statutes;

AND

WHEREAS there are no Statutes in existence regarding constitution of Faculties and Board of Studies as per Section 32(2) and 36(1) of the Act. The faculties have been constituted by Direction No. 2 of 1999 under the provision of Section 16 (8) of Maharashtra University of Health Sciences Act 1998;

AND

WHEREAS the necessary Statutes are yet to be made; making of Statute is time taking process;

Now, therefore I, **Prof. Dr. Arun. V. Jamkar**, Vice-Chancellor of the University in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under sub-section 8 of Section 16 of Maharashtra University of Health Sciences Act, 1998 issue the following Direction:

- 1) This Direction shall be called “Constitution of Board of Studies”.
- 2) It shall come into force with effect from the date of its issuance.

3) **With the issuance of this Direction, earlier Direction (No.05/2006) on the subject – matter stands repealed.**

4) There shall be following Board of Studies and the Departments under each Board in various faculties.

5) Where there are no Board of Studies in the subject or group of subjects, the Vice-Chancellor shall constitute an Ad-hoc Board of Studies in the subject or group of subjects.

The Ad-hoc Board shall consist of the following members :

- a) One Head of the **each** concerned Dept. of the affiliated colleges/ recognized institutions nominated by the Vice- Chancellor.
- b) Chairman, Board of Studies of the concerned broad speciality.
- c) Four subject experts to be nominated by the Vice –Chancellor.
- d) The Vice- Chancellor shall appoint one of the member as the Chairman of the Ad-hoc Board.

- 6) The Ad-hoc Board shall exercise powers and perform duties of the regular Board of Studies, except that by virtue of their membership of Ad-hoc Board, they shall not be eligible for membership of any authority / body of the University.

Provided that the Chairman of the Ad-hoc Board shall be invitee of the concerned faculty and the Academic Council and shall have right to be present, speak but shall not be entitled to vote and contest any election.

- 7) This Direction shall remain in force until Statute is made in this behalf by the University and assented by Hon'ble Chancellor.
