

Oral / Poster presentation Guidelines

1. Only original research papers are invited for presentation.
2. Scientific abstracts will be screened by Scientific Committee & their decision would be final.
3. Selected papers authors will be informed well in advanced.
4. Please indicate clearly whether you intend to present the paper at oral/poster session.

How to Submit?

1. Abstract should not exceed more than 250 words
2. It should be structured (in the form of Introduction, Aim, Objective, Material & Methods, Result and Discussion)
3. Times New Roman Font with size of 12 should be use for writing abstract.
4. Scanned copy of oral/ Poster presentation form signed by guide should be E-mailed with abstract.
5. Shortlisted candidates should submit power point presentation on the day of conference i.e. on 21st March 2009 at registration counter with form, on or before 08:00 am.
6. Last date for submission abstract is 5th March 2010.
7. Abstract should be send to the conference secretariat on pharmamedicine2010@gmail.com

Rules for Oral paper presentation

1. Paper presentation will start sharp on 08:00 am on the day of conference.
2. Each student will get 6 minutes for presentation + 2 minutes for question answer
3. Power point presentation should be in structured format i.e. Aim, objectives, Introduction, Materials & Methods, Result & discussion and conclusion.

POSTER SESSION

Poster presentations are increasingly being considered the most effective way of communicating with fellow researchers, as it provides a platform for one to one interaction. Therefore, in this conference most of the free papers will be in the form of posters. The evaluation will be done by the experts. At least one author should be available at site for interaction (Who is registered for conference)

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PREPARATION OF POSTERS

Poster Size

The board for posters measures approximately length 44 inches X breadth 22 inches. Pins for mounting the poster will be available at the site.

Heading

Poster should have a heading at the top that spans its full width and includes the title, the name(s) of the author(s) and affiliation(s).

Content

The main body of the poster should include subheadings such as Introduction, Materials and Methods/ Experimental Procedures, Results, Discussion, Conclusion. The use of diagrams is encouraged especially if it reduces the text.

Format

The title must be large enough to be viewed from a distance of three meters. The title should be in 96pt character size with the names of the authors and affiliations in 72pt. The subheadings should be bold with 48pt character size and all text including figure legends in 28pt character size.

Time

The Authors are required to mount their material **at 7.30 am** and remove it between **5.00 – 5.30 pm** the same day (**21st March 2010**). If a poster is not removed, the poster material shall be discarded.

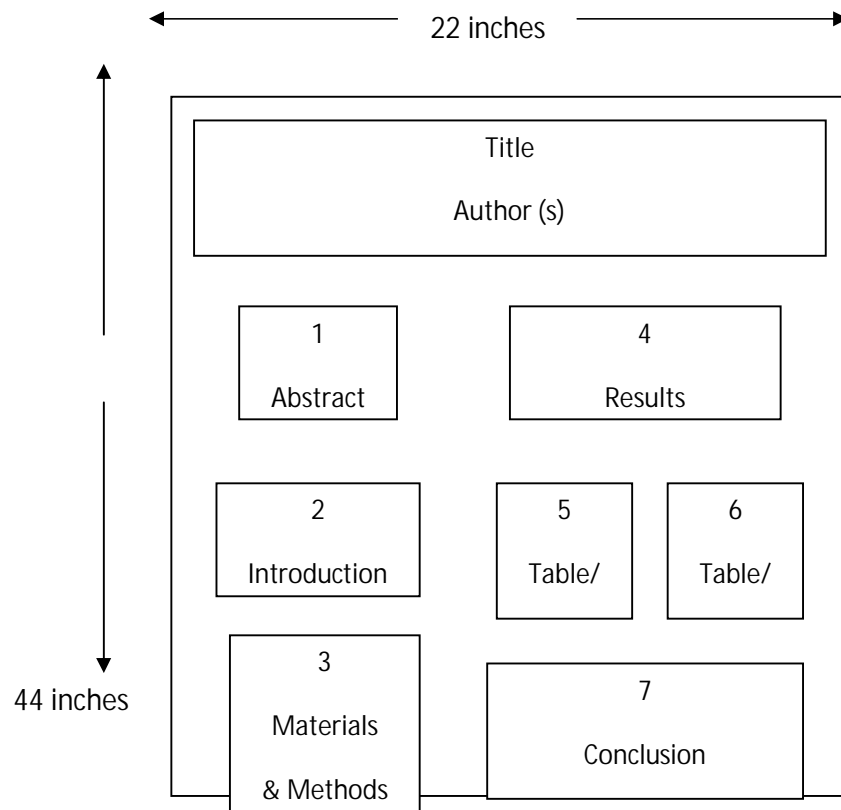
Caution:
