



- 4) The Dissertation should be written under the following headings.
  - i) Introduction.
  - ii) Aims or objectives.
  - iii) Review of Literature.
  - iv) Material and Methods.
  - v) Results and Tables.
  - vi) Discussion.
  - vii) Conclusion.
  - viii) Summary (for MPTh)
  - ix) Reference Vancouver style.
  - x) Annexures
- 5) Course and subject shall be embossed / Labeled on the top of the Dissertation cover (eg.- MPTh Musculoskeletal Sciences).
- 6) The written text of Dissertation shall be not less than 50 pages excluding references tables, questionnaires and other annexures. It should be neatly typed preferably by using font style 'Arial' size12 in double line spacing on one side of paper (A4 size, 8.27" X 11.69") and bound properly. Spiral binding should not be done. The Dissertation shall be certified by the Guide, Head of the Department and Head of the Institution (**Certificate page must be detachable and placed at the end** – if declaration and acknowledgement certificate is attached, it should be by the side of certificate in **detachable** condition).
- 7) **Five** hard copies of Dissertation along with one set of VCD/DVDs thus prepared shall be submitted. VCD/DVD shall be submitted separately with endorsing the details as mentioned in the first page (except topic name).
- 8) In clinical photographs, if included in the Dissertation, the identity of subjects should be concealed. The names of the patients should not be stated in the master chart.
- 9) Individual, College area and any sort of identity **should not** be disclosed in the Dissertation.
- 10) No identity to be disclosed in the **title** of Dissertation.
- 11) Approval of Dissertation work is an essential pre-condition for a candidate to appear in the University examinations.
- 12) Dissertation shall be submitted to the University **six** months before the final examination or on or before the dates notified by the University. Candidate submitting Dissertation after the last date shall not be eligible to appear in University examination even if he/she is issued Hall ticket/Admit card.
- 13) In case Dissertation is rejected, the candidate will have to appear in next Summer/Winter examination as applicable after making necessary modification and resubmission.
