**NOTIFICATION NO. 09/2011**

- Sub. :** Imposing fine/additional penalty on the defaulting colleges for submission of the Internal Assessment final results marklist of students to the University after the specified date (before start of theory exams) or after theory examinations or after declaration of results.
- Ref. :** 1. Clause No. 59.4 of Ordinance 1/2002 (Amended).

This is to inform to all the Deans/Principals of colleges/Institutions affiliated with MUHS, Nashik that :-

- The colleges are supposed to forward the Internal Assessment final results marklists to the University by the specified date as being communicated before the start of University theory exams in accordance with clause 59.4 of Ordinance 01/2002 (Amended).
- The University regularly issues the notification with a cut-of-date to all the colleges for submission of the Internal Assessment final results marklists to the University for Summer & Winter exams.
- The inordinate delay in submission of Internal Assessment final results marklists by the colleges are not being accepted by the University after start of theory exams/after declaration of regular results to avoid any kind of possibility of manipulation/malpractice.

Recently in a case of non-acceptance of Internal Assessment marks of a student submitted very late by the college to the University was challenged by the aggrieved student in the High Court of Judicature at Bombay, bench at Nagpur wherein the Hon'ble Court in its judgment dt. 23/12/2010 had opined that **"It was obligatory on the part of the University to take immediate action against the defaulting college to give a message to the other colleges that if they do not adhere to the time-schedule fixed by**

**the University can not be allowed to run the colleges according to their sweet whims and caprices and cause loss and/or prejudice to the students”**. The Hon'ble court has directed the University to propose action against the concerned defaulting College.

In view of the above, the said matter was placed before the BOE & Management Council for deliberation and decision. It has been unanimously resolved the following by both the authorities

- a) The University shall accept the Internal Assessment final results marklists submitted by the colleges having no fault of the student(s) **after the cut-off-date** (but before start of the University theory exams) **with Fine of sum of Rs. 2,000/-** from the concerned colleges and complete the results processing.
- b) If any college forwards the Internal Assessment results marklist to the University **after start of the theory exams or after declaration of the regular results** having no fault of student(s) shall accept the Internal Assessment final results marklists submitted by the colleges **and declare the results of the concerned student(s) subject to payment of Fine of sum of Rs. 10,000/- and strict warning to the concerned Dean/Principal.**
- c) In case of **recurrence of inordinate delay in submission of the Internal Assessment final results marklist** by the same college having no fault of student(s), it will be accepted by the University and results of the concerned students shall be declared. However, the matter shall be referred to the BOE for **imposing additional punishment to the defaulter teacher/HOD/Dean/Principal i.e. Debarment from participating in any exam related work for 5 years (in addition to fine of Rs. 10,000/-).**

**Note** – Please note that If the college finds that the imposition of the said fine is due to some unsustainable conduct/lapse by any teacher/staff, the college would be at liberty to recover the amount of fine from such teacher/staff accordingly. Also note that after imposition of fine no representation/request to condone the lapse will be entertained by the University.
